How do I actually pray for priests?

- **Pray a heartfelt Hail Mary** daily for the sanctification of your priest.
- **Pray a daily Rosary** for your assigned priest.
- **Offer your time in Eucharistic Adoration** for your assigned priest.
- **Offer some form of penance or fasting** for you priest's holiness.
- **Or pray a mix of any of the above**, as long as you pray for him each day.
